What we aim to do

The aim of the nursery is to support parent's essential work and involve them in their child's pre-school life and education.

How we will achieve this

We will:

- make all new parents aware of the nursery's systems and policies.
- ensure that parents are informed on a regular basis about their child's progress.
- ensure that all parents have opportunities to contribute from their own skills, knowledge and interests to the activities of the group.
- involve parents in shared record keeping about their own child, either formally or informally.
- ensure that all parents are fully informed about workshops and training
- hold meetings in venues which are accessible and appropriate for all.
- welcome the contributions of parents, whatever form these may take.
- make known to all parents the systems for registering queries, complaints or suggestions.
- provide opportunities for parents to learn about the EYFS and about young children's learning, in nursery and at home via regular informal communication, newsletters and e-mails.
- Ask for parent's views and respond to their answers via verbal or written feedback.
